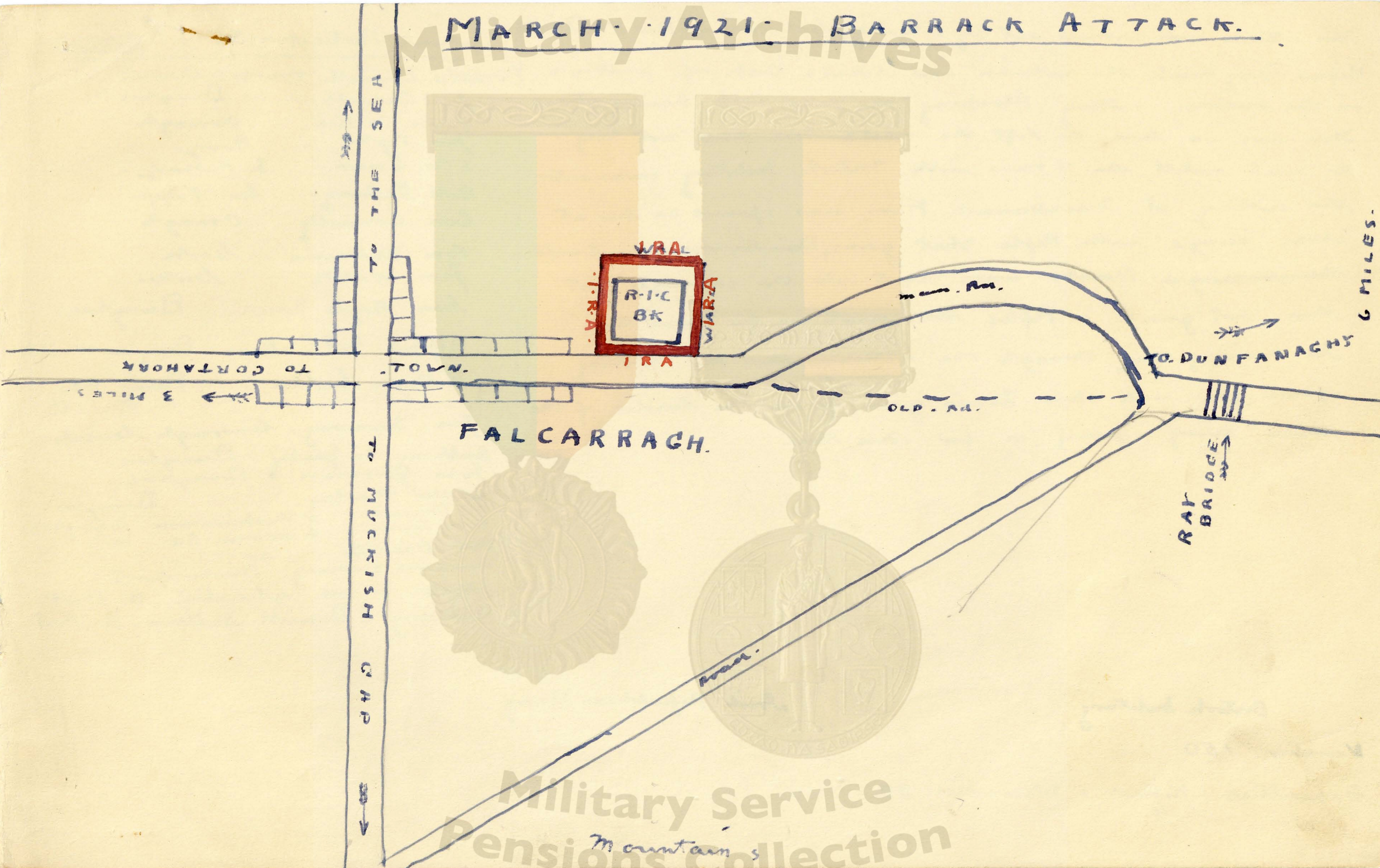


MARCH 1921 BARRACK ATTACK.

This attack was carried out by Flying Column under P.O. Donnell
 Before day break the column and loads took up positions
 on the railway cutting blocking the line with heavy stones
 There was no time to left the rails we had not long
 to wait until the Train with British Military came into
 the cutting at Meenbanead. Fire was opened on her at
 close range with Rifle shot guns, ~~Bombs were sent into~~
~~the carriages~~ Bombs were sent into the carriages first
 then shot guns & Rifles this went on for some time
 The train getting through the cutting then the Military
 opened fire with their Lewis gun from the tender of the
 train firing going on for some time
